

EYAL Chelmsford 10th May 2015

Chelmsford played host to teams from Bedford, Basildon, CAT's, Harlow, Southend, and Herts & Ware on Sunday, in Round 2 of the Eastern Young Athletes League. Bedford in particular proved extremely stiff competition, and won the fixture on the day, with Basildon in second, and Chelmsford just behind in third.

Both the U17 Men, and U17 Women did win their own age categories though, and there were plenty of excellent individual performances. Once again, U15's Laura Runciman (Shot and Hammer) and Connie Forman (75mH and Long Jump) were amongst the biggest points scorers on the day – both winning two events each. They were matched by U17 Gabby Quigley, who won both the Shot and Discus – and by U13 Seb Clatworthy, who won his High Jump and Javelin.
