

## Report from YDL Lower Age Group – Brighton – 30<sup>th</sup> May 2015

Chelmsford's younger age group (U13 and U15) athletes moved into second place in the YDL league table, after finishing equal third in their second fixture of the season at Brighton on Saturday.
